What is Base Camp?

As one of the key focal points of the Keswick Convention, Base Camp is a vibrant hub of activity, hosting our famous global mission agency exhibition, which helps to engage and connect conventioners with mission beyond their time in Keswick.

We're looking for agencies to exhibit who share the Keswick value of SERVING, with a specific passion for helping our conventioners find how God might be calling and equipping them to engage with His mission both at home and abroad.

We don't want our conventioners to leave having heard great teaching but without knowing what their next steps are, so we invite you to think about how you can help people discern their path. Could they pray? Become a financial supporter? Volunteer? Be an overseas missionary? Rather than being a centre for transactions, Base Camp is a centre for transformation as we all collaborate in mission, in community.





What will I find there?

In addition to our Mission Agencies Exhibition, Base Camp will host a bookshop, café, seminars and live relay of the morning Bible Readings and Evening Celebrations. Each week exhibitors will be invited to contribute by taking part in our Mission in 1 Minute slots.

As an exhibitor you will be invited to a daily prayer time before the venue opens for the evening session to instil a sense of prayerful community, and there will be access to a lounge space for you to relax and recharge during your breaks. Does that sound like an exhibition you want to be a part of? Come and be a part of it! We'd love to see you there.

Who can be involved?

Keswick Ministries welcomes all those agencies who are registered Christian charities, committed to the cause of global mission and who can align themselves with the values described in our 'Introducing Keswick Ministries' document.

Organisations applying to be part of the Base Camp mission exhibition much be a member of Global Connections or the Evangelical Alliance.

They should also be agencies who:

- Mobilise people into service at home or abroad
- Resource the local church and Christians for mission
- Provide training for Christian service

The 2023 Convention will explore what it means for humans to be in God's image, how it is to be lived out, how it is challenged in contemporary debates, and how that sinmarred image is renewed in Christ, fully human and fully God.

For all exhibitors, the stand price includes:

- 'Mission in 1 Minute' soapbox slot
- Website listing simply provide:
 - o a short description of your organisation (20-35 words)
 - o a link to your website
 - o a copy of your logo
- Job advert displayed on Base Camp notice board, size A4 (to be sent ahead of time)
- 2-3 PowerPoint slides about your mission agency (with agency logo on each slide)
- One power socket
- One table (6ft x 2ft) and chairs
- Access to team lounge

Please note the following:

- Your display stand must be free standing. Please keep your stand within your allocated space so that we can keep aisles clear and safe for people to move around.
- Whilst we endeavour to provide good quality lighting, you might wat to bring your own additional lighting to ensure your stand is well lit.
- Please feel free to bring literature, resources, pens, DVDs, books and CDs to give away, but the sale of books, CDs and DVDs is reserved for the bookshop. We encourage you to contact the bookshop ahead of the Convention if there are specific resources you would like to be stocked. 10ofthose will be running the bookshop.
- Agencies need to provide their own accommodation, food and car parking for those manning their stands.
- We understand this is not always possible, but we recommend 4 people per agency. This will enable everyone to have a break and not be the only one manning the stand.


